## **TRANSITIONAL ECONOMIES: THE CZECH REPUBLIC**

### **Program Description:**

This course will discuss history of economic thought and the intellectual wave which grew so vast that at one time nearly one-third of the world's nations embraced socialism. Today only a few press on – we will look at them too. As a special topics course with a study abroad component, we will focus somewhat heavily on the Czech Republic this semester. Students will learn the material from the perspectives of American and Czech scholars and business persons. Students can expect a highly integrative learning experience in which we will study the transitional economies in an interdisciplinary fashion. Importantly, students will personally experience much of what is discussed when we take our spring break field trip to the Czech Republic!
