Program Description:

This program is intended to expose students to a cross-section of Eastern European Architecture, Art and Design. The course will include lectures and seminar-based discussion forums regarding the various examples and locations we will visit and study. In addition, freehand sketching, photography and digital image making techniques will be taught and utilized to better study and understand the cultural artifacts of design that we will visit. As the class moves from Southern to Northern Europe, we will investigate the shift in styles and construction types associated with the variations in local environment and cultural context.
