



4 WEEK FRENCH LANGUAGE PROGRAM IN TOURS

Program Description:

Learn French in the heartland of France! Spend four weeks in the city of Tours, a vibrant university town of 300,000 in the Loire Valley, located just one hour southwest of Paris. Immerse yourself in the French language and culture through intensive classes at the Institut de Touraine. While living with local French host families, students will explore the historic medieval district in Tours and soak up regional culture, including one full-day excursion and two half-day excursions to the famous châteaux and sites of Touraine. Students will also discover the City of Lights, with a four-night stay in Paris, taking a boat ride on the Seine river and visiting major cultural sites such as the palace of Versailles, Arc de Triomphe, Montmartre and world-class museums.

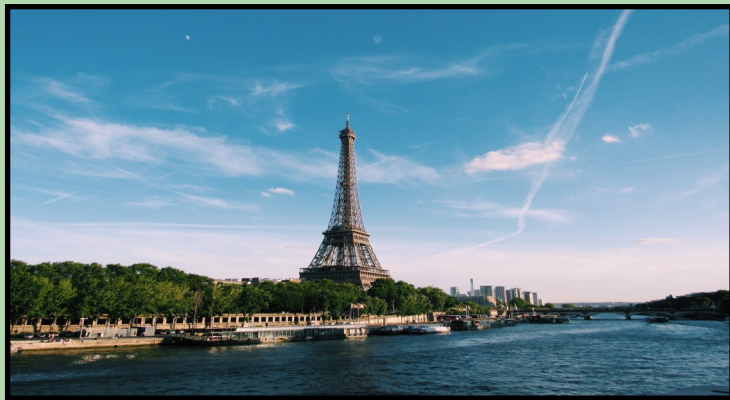
