



TROPICAL VETERINARY MEDICINE & ONE HEALTH IN UGANDA

Program Description:

This course focuses on One Health, international animal production and health management, disease surveillance, public health systems, food safety and security, and multi-national cultural exposure. The course is delivered in collaboration with Makerere University in Kampala, Uganda, and uses mainly experiential field trips (i.e. farms, field experiment stations and national parks). There is a cultural boma (workshop) and international conference during the last week. Students also visit selected sites of interest such as The Equator and optional excursions and experiences such as a Chimpanzee and Gorilla tracking, white water rafting and bungee jumping.
