### WHAT ARE SHORT-TERM PROGRAMS?

They are three- to eight-week programs designed between Mississippi State University's English Language Institute (ELI) and an international group, such as a university or a business. Each program is designed to fit the group's needs and requests.



### WHY SHOULD WE DO SHORT-TERM PROGRAMS?

- A safe, cost-effective way for study abroad opportunities
- Lead to or strengthen exchange agreements
- Facilitate relationships between departmental faculty and international students

## THE TYPICAL SHORT-TERM PROGRAM AT MISSISSIPPI STATE UNIVERSITY

### ENGLISH COURSE WORK & PROGRAM

- Student orientation and placement exam
- 8 language levels
- 20 hours per week of instruction, integrating all skills
- Textbooks included
- Certificate and letter of program participation for each student

### CULTURE ACTIVITIES

- Weekend trip to a major Southern city
- Day trip to a major Southern city
- Mississippi State University sporting and cultural events (some optional and paid by the student)
- City of Starkville and state of Mississippi civic cultural events
- Welcome and farewell receptions
- Weekly conversation club
- ELI student computer lab
- ELI sponsored weekly cultural events

### CAMPUS SERVICES

- Use of campus dining facilities, libraries, and campus computer labs
- Provisions for on-campus housing and linens
- Entry to the recreational center
- Access to the student health center
- Processing of immigration documents



### WHAT IS INCLUDED IN THE COSTS?

Costs are determined by the number of weeks, instructional hours, culture activities, campus services, medical requirements, and other program services.

Typical costs include tuition, housing, textbooks, fitness center fees, health center fees (X-rays and required medical screenings), student health insurance, weekend trip, day trip, and group airport transportation to and from a regional airport.

Travel to and from the United States and personal expenses (including some optional cultural and sporting events) are not included in the program cost. In most cases, food is not included in program costs.

### TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- The American Language & Culture program is a group program for participants of 15 or more.
- Participants should plan to arrive and depart in a group.
- Proof of funding for I-20 issuance is required.
