## **OSA SCHOLARSHIPS**

The Office of Study Abroad offers partial scholarships to select MSU students for approved programs. Generally, scholarships range from \$250 - \$2,000 per student, but award amounts vary. Scholarships are awarded based on financial need and the expected benefit of the study abroad experience.

## **EXCHANGE PARTNERS**

MSU students enroll directly at the host institution and receive transfer credit at MSU. Some exchange programs are open only to students of a particular major. It is not always required to speak the language of the host country to study abroad at the host institution. Many universities have some or all coursework in English.

## **PROVIDER COMPANIES**

These programs are organized by an outside company working directly with universities abroad. Programs are comprised of students from across the United States - not necessarily MSU students. Classes are often taught in English; however, students with sufficient knowledge of a foreign language may choose to take foreign language courses and/or courses instructed in a foreign language.
