

## **National Study Abroad Scholarship Opportunities:**

- Association of Teachers of Japanese Bridging Project- The Bridging Project offers scholarships to American undergraduate students participating in study abroad programs in Japan. - The Barry M. Goldwater Scholarship- American citizens/ residents who will be college
  juniors and seniors during the study abroad and intend to pursue careers in mathematics, the
  natural sciences, or engineering. Study abroad can take place worldwide.

- Benjamin A. Gilman International Scholarship Program- U.S. citizen undergraduates, in good academic standing, who receive a Federal Pell Grant, will be attending an approved program and will study abroad for at least 28 days. The Program especially supports: Students with high financial need; Students with diverse ethnic backgrounds; Students with disabilities. - Boren Awards for International Study- Provides American undergraduate students with the
  resources and encouragement they need to acquire skills and experiences in areas of the
  world critical to the future security of our nation, in exchange for their commitment to seek
  work in the federal government. The program focuses on geographic areas, languages, and

- DAAD Undergraduate Scholarship- The goal of this program is to support study abroad in Germany and at German universities. - Fund for Education Abroad- General Scholarship- Fund for Education Abroad awards
  are intended to support students planning to participate in high-quality, rigorous education

  permanent residents currently enrolled as undergraduates in US universities/colleges who

- Fund for Education Abroad- Hilary Echo Douglas Memorial Scholarship- This
  scholarship will be awarded to a student who demonstrates Hilary's love for Vietnam and

  life. Applicants must be US citizens or permanent residents currently enrolled as


