- Association of Teachers of Japanese Bridging Project: The U.S.-Japan Bridging
 Foundation provides scholarships for American undergraduates to study in Japan for a

- The Barry M. Goldwater Scholarship: American citizens residents who will be college
 juniors and seniors during the study abroad and intend to pursue careers in mathematics, the
 natural sciences, or engineering can apply. Study abroad can take place worldwide.

- Benjamin A. Gilman International Scholarship Program: U.S. citizen undergraduates, in
 good academic standing, who receive a Federal Pell Grant, will be attending an approved
 program and will study abroad for at least 21 days in the same country. The Program
 especially supports students with high financial need, students with diverse ethnic
 backgrounds, and students with disabilities. Higher rate of scholarships given to students
 studying in diverse countries, especially those outside of Western Europe and Australia.

- Boren Awards for International Study: Provides American undergraduate students with the
 resources and encouragement they need to acquire skills and experiences in areas of the
 world critical to the future security of our nation, in exchange for their commitment to seek
 work in the federal government. The program focuses on geographic areas, languages, and

- DAAD Undergraduate Scholarship: The goal of this program is to support study abroad in Germany and at German universities. - Freeman-ASAI: Freeman-ASIA accepts applications from U.S. citizens or permanent residents studying at the undergraduate level at a two-year or four-year college or university who demonstrate financial need to study abroad in East or Southeast Asia. http://www.iie.org/en/Programs/Freeman-ASIA
- Diverse Women of Color Study Abroad Scholarship: The Diverse International Women of Color Study Abroad Scholarship is intended to assist women of color who are exceptional in their studies and in need of financial assistance to study abroad. - Fund for Education Abroad- General Scholarship: Fund for Education Abroad awards are
 intended to support students planning to participate in high-quality, rigorous education abroad
 programs in the academic year or summer. Applicants must be US citizens or permanent
 residents currently enrolled as undergraduates in US universities/colleges who plan to study

 Phi Kappa Phi Study Abroad Grants: Phi Kappa Phi Study Abroad Grants are designed to help support undergraduates as they seek knowledge and experience in their academic fields by studying abroad.
